This twenty year Master Plan (2000 - 2020) for Lehigh University addressed near and long-term strategies for the campus's diverse land holdings. The plan reinforces the collegiality of the historic Packer campus, capitalizes on the opportunities inherent in the diversity and remedies the existing campus environment. Primary goals were to create a pedestrian-friendly campus which restricts the imposition of vehicles and parking, to renovate and restore its venerated buildings and to integrate the University with the urban South Side Bethlehem community. A research park was envisioned on E-Mountain for the Mountaintop Campus to raise revenue for the University and to leverage existing academic and open space holdings.
