The Campus Master Plan was envisioned as a practical blueprint for ten-year plan and long-term conceptual planning for a 3,300 acre Ralph-Adams Cram master planned residential college for women. 21 of 34 buildings comprise the Sweet Briar National Historic District.

The College was seeking to increase its enrollment, while maintaining a year-long residential campus experience for women with improved student life facilities, enhanced academic facilities, increased on-campus residential opportunities that strengthen community-building.

These goals were accomplished by relocating housing to the west side of the academic campus, consolidating library services, upgrading faculty housing, designing a new center for student life, consolidating disparate programs, and upgrading athletics facilities.
