Programming, Site Planning
and Landscape Concept Design

In 2001, North Carolina A&T began a planning and programming process for the design of new residence halls as the implementation of the first phase of the Campus Master Plan completed in 2001. The purpose of the study was to develop a program for the design of an innovative living-learning community of 1,000 units of new student housing; to develop a design for the siting and phasing of new residence halls; and to develop a conceptual design for the landscape of the neighborhood and new campus mall.
